## What programs are offered by School of Economics?

School of Economics hosts field trips for grades 2-6 as well as Homeschool Camps, Girl Scout programs, and Non-Profit student groups

### What is the cost?

The cost is \$15/student. There is no cost for adult staff and volunteers. We do offer a sliding scale for schools with greater than 60% free/reduced lunch.

### How many volunteers would my school need?

Schools/groups need a minimum of 12 volunteers. SOE has a few community volunteers available to help reach the minimum if needed.

# How long is the field trip?

Field trips take 4 hours to complete all the activities.

### What is the preparation for the field trip?

Teachers will facilitate student preparation by making sure they have a job and having them fill out business preparation paperwork.

#### What does a typical field trip look like?

Students will go to work to set up a food and craft business. Once set up, shops will sell their goods as students take breaks from work to spend their paycheck dollars. At the end, shops will clean their areas and learn which businesses made a profit.
