- SOE is for elementary students typically grades 2nd 6th.
- SOE has two locations Blue Springs and Kansas City. Both were fully booked for the 2022-23 school year with a waitlist of over 3,000 students.
- SOE has two programs, SOE Market and Mini-Town around 15,000 students served.
- We launched a brand-new program in Kansas City, Mini-town for third graders it was very successful.
- Continued successful bank partnership with Lead Bank in Blue Springs.
- Successfully renewed a three-year partnership with UMB bank. Thanks for the continued support and generosity!
- SOE at UMB had a 44% increase in students served since 2021.
- SOE in Blue Springs had a 60% increase in students served since 2021.
- Overall, our Marketplace program had a 52% increase in the number of students served over the past year.
- We had a 45% increase in the number of volunteers serving at SOE over the past year.
- Over 315,000 students have been served to date.
- SOE served 45 public schools and 38 private/charter schools that surround the Greater Kansas City area.
- Realigned staffing to include two full-time Program Manager positions, one at each location.
